Where? Deansrath Health Centre, Clondalkin & Ballyfermot Primary Care Centre.

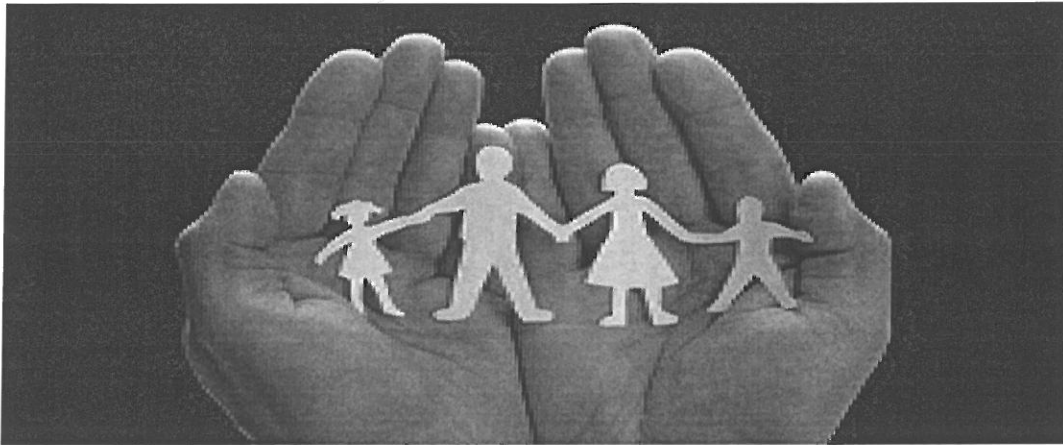
When? Last Wednesday of every month,

PARENTING & PSYCHOLOGY CLINIC



THIS CLINIC IS DESIGNED FOR PARENTS WHO HAVE QUESTIONS/CONCERNS ABOUT THEIR CHILD

Q. Who is the clinic for?

A. Parents or carers of children aged from 1 – 18 years (Not the children themselves).

Q. What issues are relevant to this clinic?

A. Any concerns that a parent may have in relation to a child's development, behaviour, adjustment to life changes such as separation/ bereavement/ divorce etc.

The clinic operates on a first-come first-served basis. Each clinic has 4 slots available, in which the parent meets with Patricia FitzPatrick, Primary Care Psychologist, to discuss the concerns on a one-to-one basis.
